According to the Associated Press, US military units searching for "Weapons of Mass Destruction" have run out of places to look. Time magazine quotes a Marine General as saying: ***"We've been to virtually every ammunition supply point between the Kuwaiti border and Baghdad... They're simply not there."***

How Come? Before the War, UN Weapons Inspector Scott Ritter reported 90% of Iraq's weapons had been destroyed by 1995. But according to Jason Leopold, the White House silenced experts who questioned the Iraq intelligence information put out by the Bush Administration. Allegations that Iraq had tried to purchase uranium from Niger were based on crude forgeries. Numerous intelligence officials have countered suggestions that Iraq ever posed any threat to the US.
