US Gov't Accomplishments - As of 12/8/05

2,135+ US Soldiers Dead

15,881+ US Soldiers Wounded

- www.antiwar.com

Estimated: 15,000 - 48,100 US Soldiers Wounded!

127,368+ Iraqi Civilians Killed

- Lancet, 10/28/04, reported 100,000+ Iraqi civilians killed, mostly women & children.

- Details of 27,368 Iraqi civilian deaths at www.iraqbodycount.net

- 400,000 Iraqi children have "chronic wasting" disease (11/21/04, W. Post)

1,018,944+ Iraqi Civ's Wounded

- Estimated using the conservative 8-to-1 wounded-to-killed ratio (11/29/04, Wash. Post)

1,018,944 = 8 x 127,368 Iraqi civilian deaths

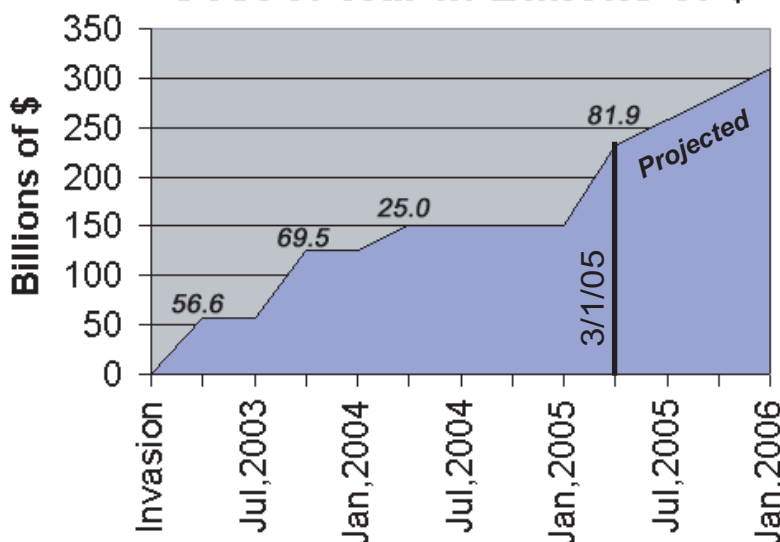
\$314+ Billion Spent (by 12/31/05)
