US Gov't Accomplishments - As of 4/18/06

2,377+ US Soldiers Dead

17,269+ US Soldiers Wounded

Estimated: 18,000 - 48,100 US Soldiers Wounded!

134,493+ Iraqi Civilians Killed

- Lancet, 10/28/04, reported 100,000+ Iraqi civilians killed, mostly women & children.

- Details of 34,493 Iraqi civilian deaths at www.iraqbodycount.net

- 400,000 Iraqi children have "chronic wasting" disease (11/21/04, W. Post)

- Does not include the 567,000+ Iraqi children killed by US sanctions.

1,075,944+ Iraqi Civ's Wounded

- Estimated using the conservative 8-to-1 wounded-to-killed ratio (11/29/04, Wash. Post)

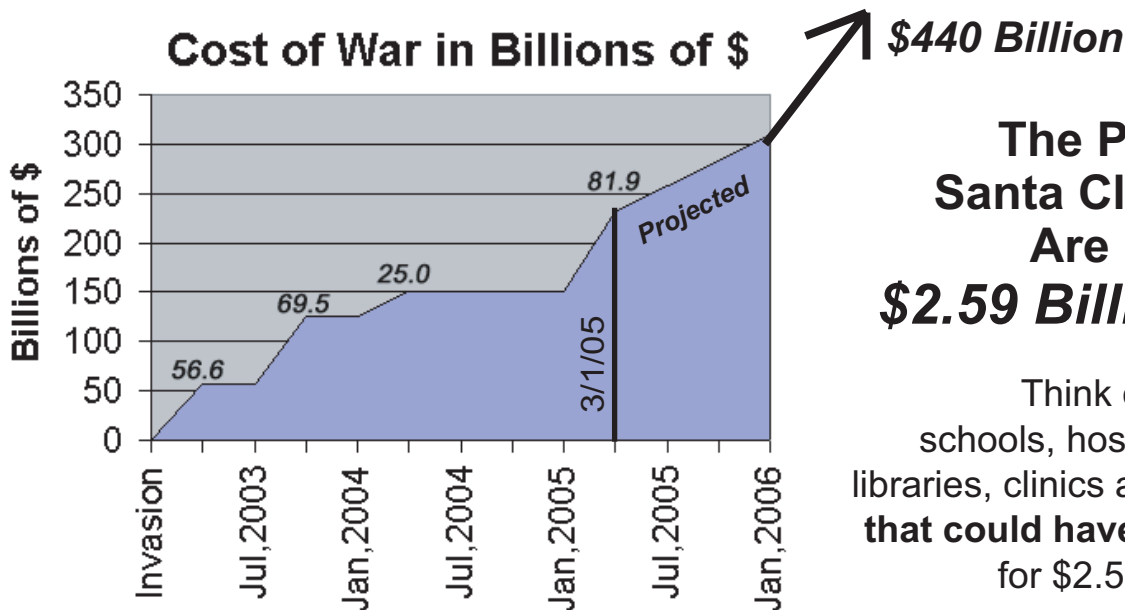
1,075,944 = 8 x 134,493 Iraqi civilian deaths
