US Gov't Accomplishments - As of 6/27/06

**2,526+ US Soldiers Dead**

**18,490+ US Soldiers Wounded**

- www.antiwar.com

Estimated up to 48,100 US Soldiers Wounded!

**138,601+ Iraqi Civilians Killed**

- Lancet, 10/28/04, reported 100,000+ Iraqi civilians killed, mostly women & children.

- Details of 38,601 Iraqi civilian deaths at [www.iraqbodycount.net](http://www.iraqbodycount.net)

- **Does not include** the 567,000+ Iraqi children killed by 13 years of US sanctions, nor any of the US-caused Iraqi Gulf War I casualties.

- 400,000 Iraqi children have "chronic wasting" disease (11/21/04, W. Post)

**1,108,808+ Iraqi Civ's Wounded**

- Estimated using the conservative 8-to-1 wounded-to-killed ratio (11/29/04, Wash. Post)

1,108,808 = 8 x 138,601 Iraqi civilian deaths

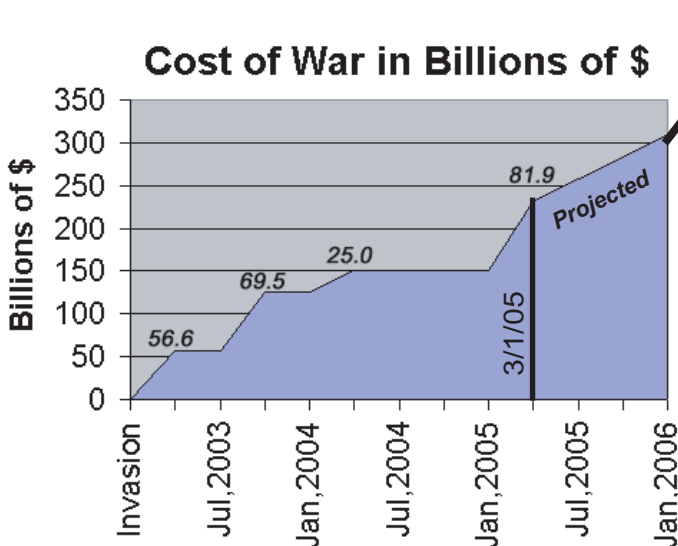
**\$506+ Billion Spent**
