US Gov't Accomplishments - As of 7/24/06

2,567+ US Soldiers Dead

18,988+ US Soldiers Wounded

- www.antiwar.com

Estimated up to 48,100 US Soldiers Wounded!

139,284+ Iraqi Civilians Killed

- Lancet, 10/28/04, reported 100,000+ Iraqi civilians killed, mostly women & children.

- Details of 39,284 Iraqi civilian deaths at www.iraqbodycount.net

- **Does not include** the 567,000+ Iraqi children killed by 13 years of US sanctions, nor any of the US-caused Iraqi Gulf War I casualties.

- 400,000 Iraqi children have "chronic wasting" disease (11/21/04, W. Post)

1,114,272+ Iraqi Civ's Wounded

- Estimated using the conservative 8-to-1 wounded-to-killed ratio (11/29/04, Wash. Post)

1,114,272 = 8 x 139,284 Iraqi civilian deaths

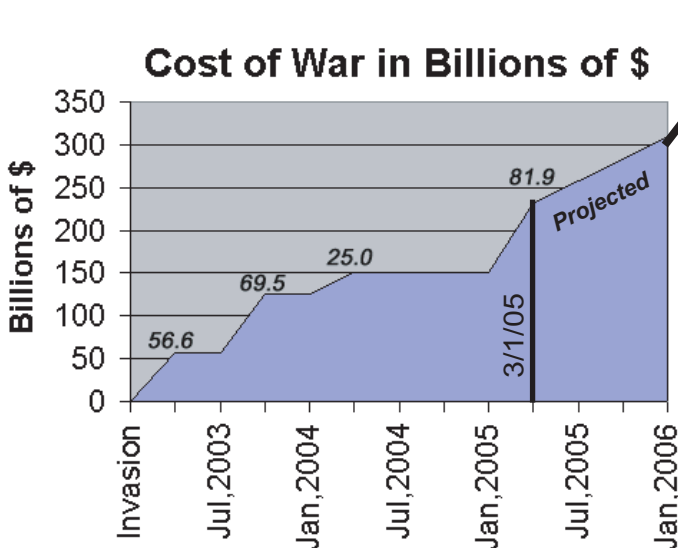
\$506+ Billion Spent
