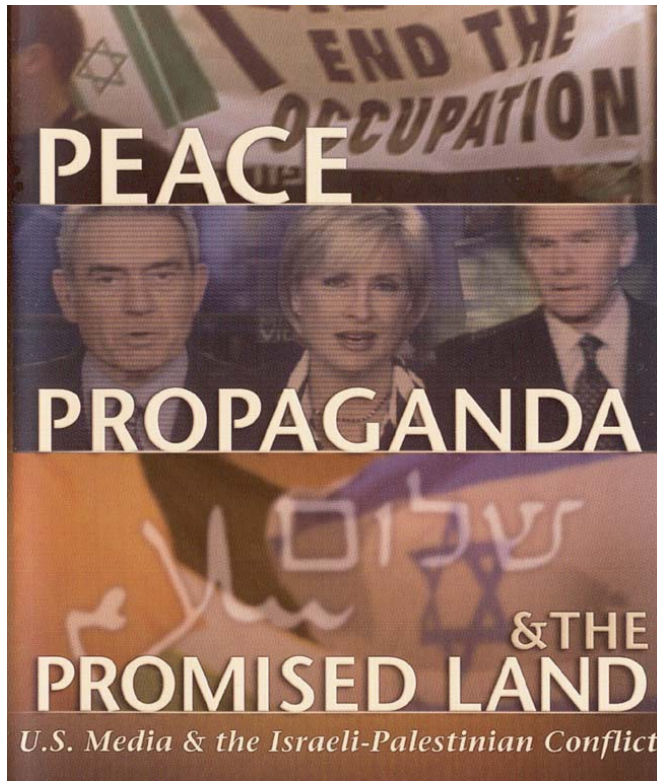


*Foreign Affairs Film Series Presents*

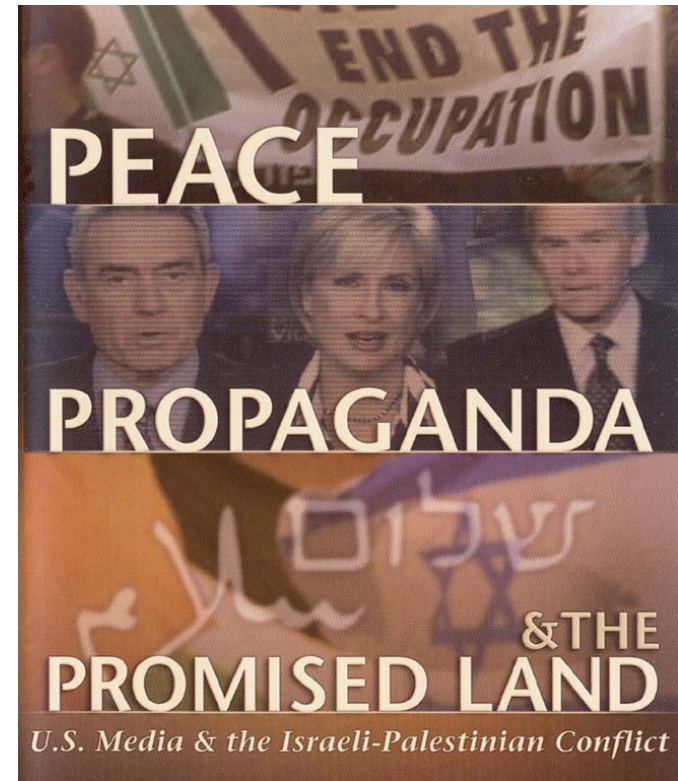
